Shorthorn

Supreme Heifer – 15 minutes following Shorthorn Show

If another breed show meets the minimum requirements, they will be added at the end of the show order.

Open to heifers and bulls two years of age and younger and Cow/Calf Pairs. Bulls over 7 months of age must be shown with a nose lead. The Calf from the pair is eligible to be show in their respective class, and the cow/calf pair is eligible for the Grand Champion in her respective breed.

Showmanship Age Groups, As of day of the show:

Pee-Wee- 6 and Under Novice-7-9 Junior- 10-12 Intermediate – 13-15 Senior – 16-21 Exhibitors must be 21 or younger as of the day of the show
